Port of Coos Bay to begin removal of Citrus Dock building on Coos Bay waterfront

The Oregon International Port of Coos Bay has contracted with Koos Environmental Services of Coos Bay to immediately begin removal and remediation of siding and flooring at the Citrus Dock building, alongside U.S. Highway 101 on the Coos Bay waterfront.

The project will remove exterior siding and trim, windows, flooring and subflooring. The contract requires the company to capture and dispose of all material as is required through Oregon Department of Environmental Quality and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency regulations. The facility has not seen consistent commercial use in more than a decade. In addition, the building contains lead paint and asbestos, which is prompting the project. Ultimately, the entire building will be dismantled once contaminants have been removed.

During the next year, the port will analyze its options for future uses of the Citrus Dock facility and the nearby Dolphin Terminal dock to the south.
