Appendix D – Vessel Statistics

Deep draft traffic slowly increased throughout 2012-2016 to a total of 63 vessel arrivals in 2016. This averages to one ship every five days. With the combined anticipated 120 LNG carriers, a total of 183 ships per year are expected to call on Coos Bay. This averages to a ship 2.3 times per week. The port has previously handled nearly 400 ships per year in a safe manner with no negative impacts.
