Job Summary

The Coos Bay Rail Line is seeking to hire a certified Conductor / Engineer to work out of the on duty location of Noti, Oregon. The ideal candidate shall have current FRA certification as a Locomotive Engineer and current FRA certification as a Conductor.

Essential Job Functions

- Ensure compliance with all FRA, ODOT Rail, and Coos Bay Rail Line rules and regulations for safety and operations.
- Ensure safe, on-time/on-plan train operation and movement in compliance with company and Federal rules and instructions.
- Inspect all equipment on cars prior to departures.
- Assist and instruct train crews to couple and uncouple cars, operate switches, and make minor repairs to railcars, including replacing heavy couplings or air brake hoses.
- Work with customers to ensure accurate movement and placement of cars.
- Maintain awareness of surrounding area and suspicious activity to ensure rail safety.
- Maintain work areas, tools, and equipment in clean and safe working order.
- Keep supervisor informed of work progress and completion. Proactively seek next work assignments upon completion of previously assigned work.

Required Experience & Education

- **MUST HAVE CURRENT FRA CERTIFICATION AS A LOCOMOTIVE ENGINEER AND CURRENT FRA CERTIFICATION AS A CONDUCTOR.**
- High School diploma or GED.
- Working experience as a Locomotive Engineer and Conductor.

- Ability to comprehend color and/or hand signals and systems.

Working Conditions

- Regional travel required.
- Work is frequently performed outside during inclement weather conditions, all shifts, and various hours.
- Work locations could include elevated heights such as bridges over waterways, dark close clearance spaces such as tunnels, and areas of uneven footing.
- May be subjected to high stress situations.
- Must utilize/wear personal protective equipment as required.

Physical Requirements

- Positions in this class typically require: climbing, climbing ladders or equipment, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, bending, crawling, reaching, reaching overhead, holding onto moving equipment, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, carrying, talking, hearing and seeing.
- Very Heavy Work: Exerting in excess of 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or in excess of 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or in excess of 20 pounds of force constantly to move objects.
- Locations include: areas of elevation, vehicle and pedestrian traffic, enclosed and/or exposed outdoor environments, wet areas, over waterways and bridges, through/in tunnels, areas of uneven footing.
- Ability to safely operate a chainsaw.
